Prepare for Registration

Registration for the WSIS+20 High-level Meeting will open soon!

You can advance the registration process by following the steps below:

- **Set up an account on INDICO**
 - All individuals must have an account on the [INDICO platform](https://indico.un.org/) to register to attend the Conference.

 - Set up your profile, including photo, documents, etc – *it will speed up the registration process!*

- **Get your letter of representation ready!**
 - Individuals applying for registration will need to demonstrate affiliation with an organization in consultative status with ECOSOC or with provable relevance to the WSIS+20 process. You can check if your organization is consultative status with ECOSOC [here](#).
 - Each organization will be allowed to request registration for up to **2 (two) delegates**.
 - Individuals will need **to attach a letter of representation** signed by the head of their organization. A template is available [here](#).
 - Registration and letter of representation must include full name as reflected in valid passport/government ID.
 - Participants must register individually through the appropriate INDICO form. The system does not allow for registrations 'in bulk'.
 - Participants under 18 years old will need to be registered and accompanied by a Chaperone who must also be duly registered to attend the Conference through the same organization. This information must be included in the affiliation letter to be uploaded to the registration platform. If chaperones are not the legal guardians, a permission letter from the parents or legal guardians must be submitted at the time of registration.

- Assistants of persons with disabilities must be fully registered to attend the Conference through the main registration channel.
