Conceptual Definitions and Principles



About Governance....

• A set of <u>rules</u> guiding management and administration

- Combines <u>stakeholders</u> and defines roles and responsibilities
- Defines <u>processes</u> on how specific things should be done



About Governance Systems....

• They exist in in some form....whether formalized or not

- The can be observed to have varied states of sophistication
- The are always guiding principles...written, unwritten, spoken or unspoken

There are <u>levels</u>



About Data Governance Systems....


Typically Define:

- The **policies** (including legislations) that guide data management
- The <u>stakeholders</u> (institutions and people) that are involved in data management
- The **processes** (especially documented ones) to be followed in data management
- The (hierarchical) levels in data management and decision-making

Understanding the Pillars



Policies

- The foundational element of data governance
- Provides *legitimacy* of the system
- Answers the question 'why'

Institutions

- Defines means of institutionalising data governance
- Provides <u>evidence</u> of the system
- Answers the question 'what'

People

- Defines means of capacitating data governance
- Provides **embodiment** of the system
- Answers the question 'who'

Processes

- Defines means of operationalisation
- Provides *mechanics* of the system
- Answers the question 'how'



Understanding the Elements



Data Standards & Classification

How does the system ensure that there are standards in data representation and how is this standardisation applied

Data Privacy

How does the system ensure that the personal data are neither abused nor used without approval of the owners

Data Sharing, Exchange & Interoperability

How does the system ensure that there are effective means of sharing data and that digital systems are interoperable

Data Infrastructure

What infrastructure does the system have to store, secure, and share Government data

Data Security

How does the system ensure that there are effective security and protection measures for data

Link with Personal Identity

How does the system enable linking personal identity for key services
