









- National Consultation Workshop










Baseline Study

- Several Initiatives in the past
- A lack of sufficient regulatory documents for legitimizing DG at national level
- Inconsistent institutional set up proposals
- The most missing elements:
 - data standardization and classification,
 - data sharing and interoperability and
 - linking data with national digital identity







