She is a seasoned Gender Analyst, Policy Advocate, and Process Consultant with over two decades of experience in development work. A professional Nutrition Extensionist, in-depth researcher, and trained conflict manager, Dr. Akinsanya brings a multidimensional approach to advancing gender equality and sustainable development.

She currently serves as the Ogun State Coordinator for the Civil Society Coalition on Sustainable Development (CSCSD) and is a member of the Steering Committee of the Transparency, Accountability & Participation (TAP) Network. Her work focuses on gender cross-cutting issues in governance, peacebuilding, health, education, and human security.

Dr. Akinsanya believes strongly that conflict prevention and peacebuilding are transformative tools for empowering women and girls economically.
