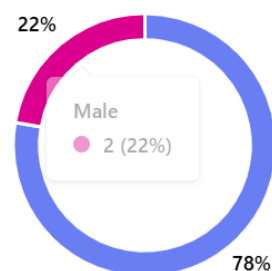


## Workshop on “Changing Mindsets for Innovation and Public Sector Transformation”

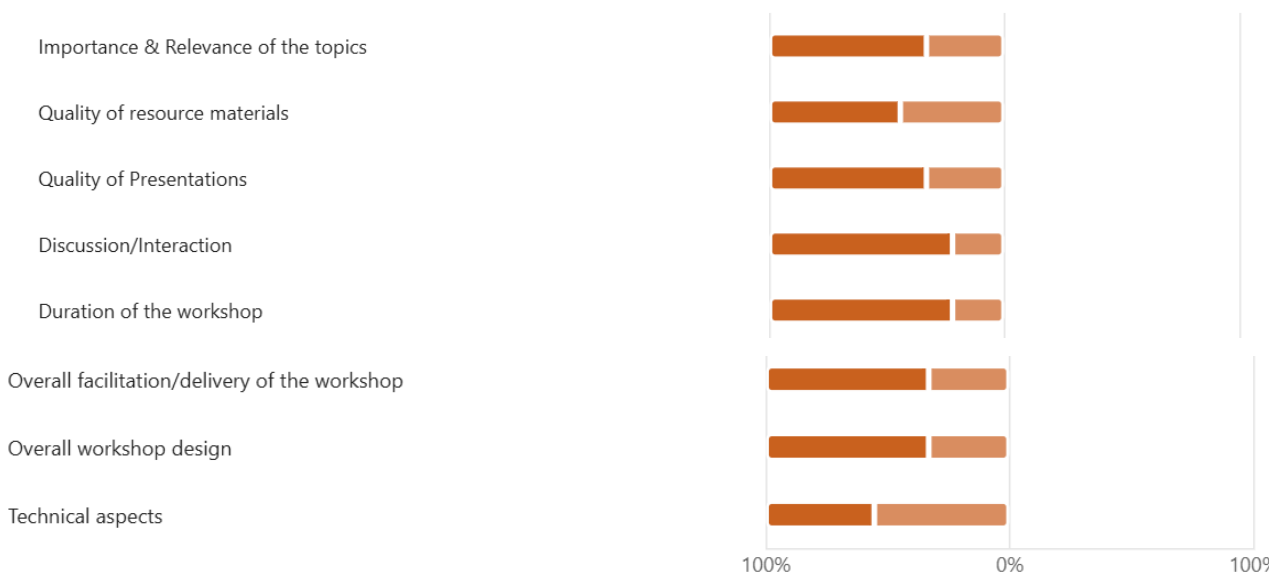

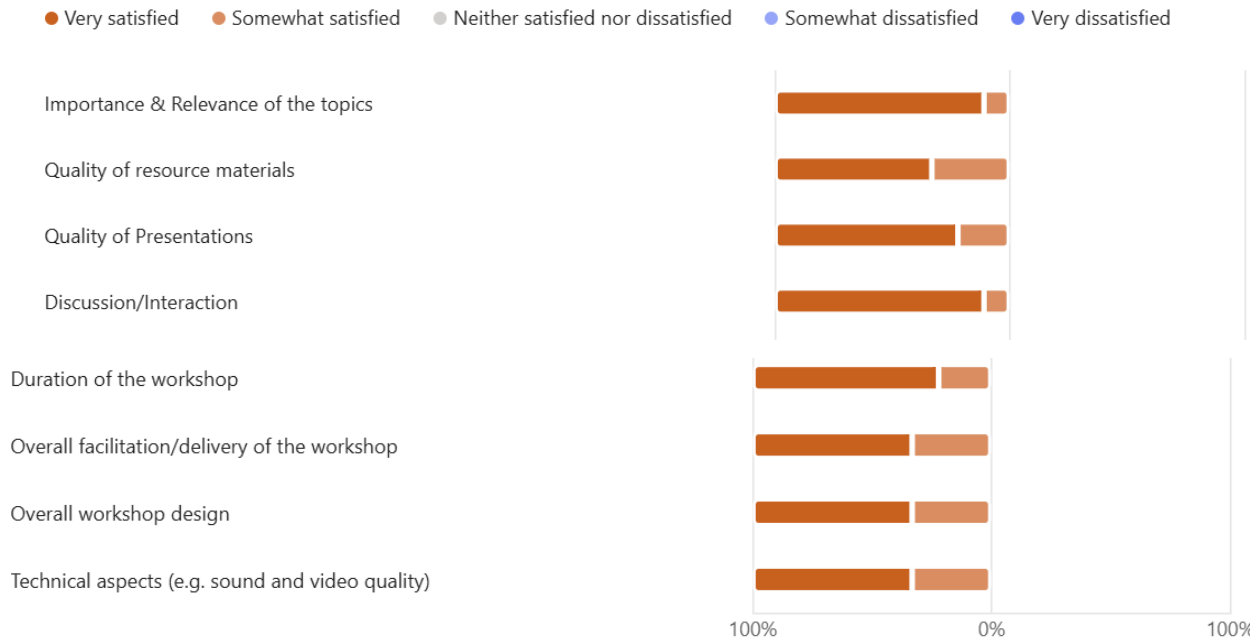


3. Please rate your level of satisfaction with the following aspects of the workshop. Please choose one in each row.

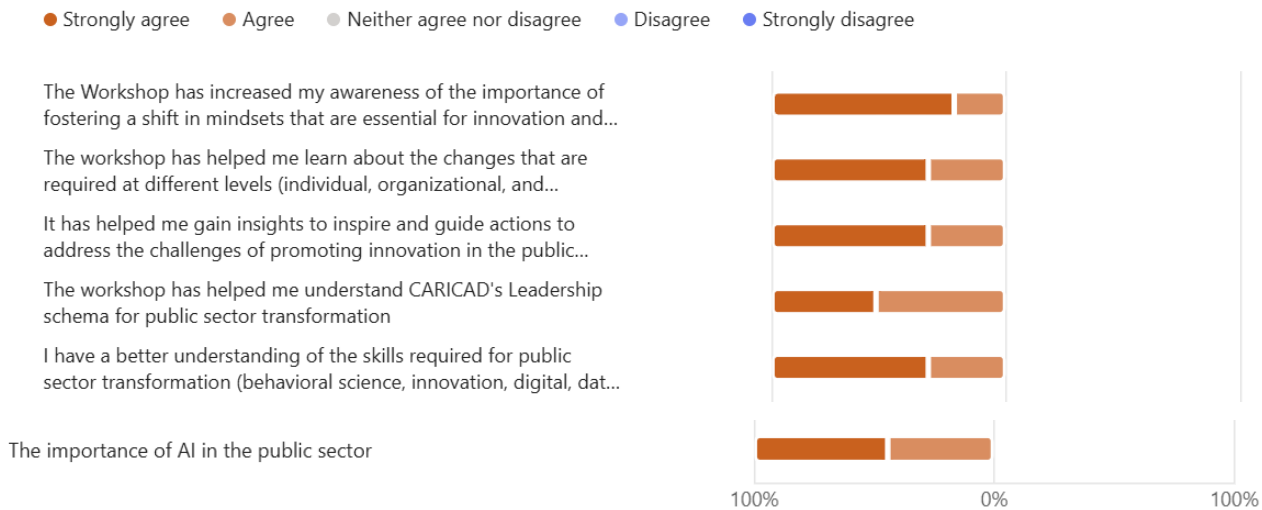
● Very satisfied

4. Please rate your level of satisfaction with the following aspects of the workshop. Please choose one in each row.



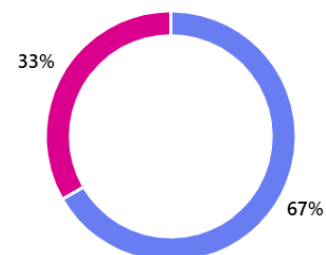

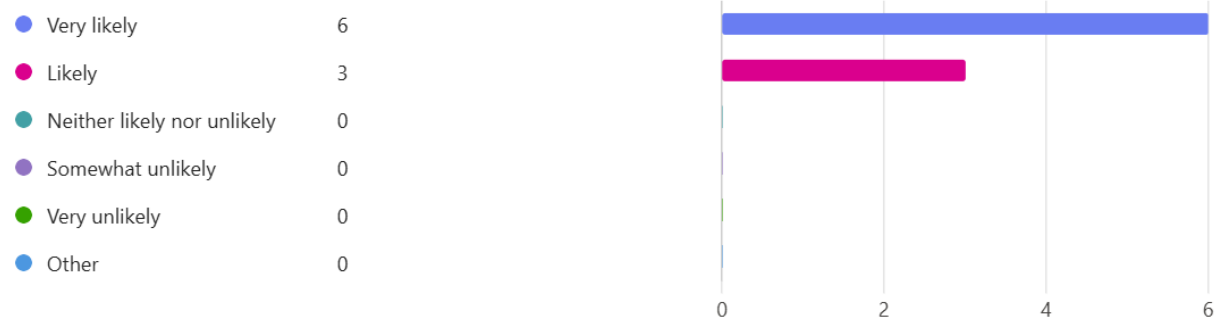
