Overarching guiding questions for the Regional Forum

- 1. Given the centrality of data for development and digital government, Governments must employ a holistic, integrated approach in developing and implementing data governance and digital government frameworks. What are some successful pathways as demonstrated by countries in Africa?
- 2. Is a whole-government framework approach to national data governance frameworks and the development of digital government feasible and sustainable? Why?
- 3. Is a multistakeholder (whole-of-society) approach equally important? How can Governments engage the private sector and civil society more effectively in the national data and digital agenda?
- 4. In the context of data governance and digital government, what are the interlinkages between national and sub-national levels (city/municipal levels), as well as at the global and regional levels? How can peer-to-peer learning and twinning arrangements (i.e., institutional cooperation between countries) be better promoted?
- 5. How can data protection measures be effectively implemented to safeguard citizen information while enhancing public service delivery?
- 6. What are the best practices for integrating data governance and digital government initiatives to enhance the efficiency of public services?
- 7. What role does digital government play in fostering economic growth and development in African countries? How can African nations collaborate to enhance data governance and digital government efforts to drive economic development in Africa?
