- Population = 120 million
- 1,112,000 square kilometres (472,000 sq. miles)
- Arable land = 34%
- 12 river basins with an annual runoff volume of 122 billion m³ of water and an estimated 2.6–6.5 billion m³ of ground water potential.



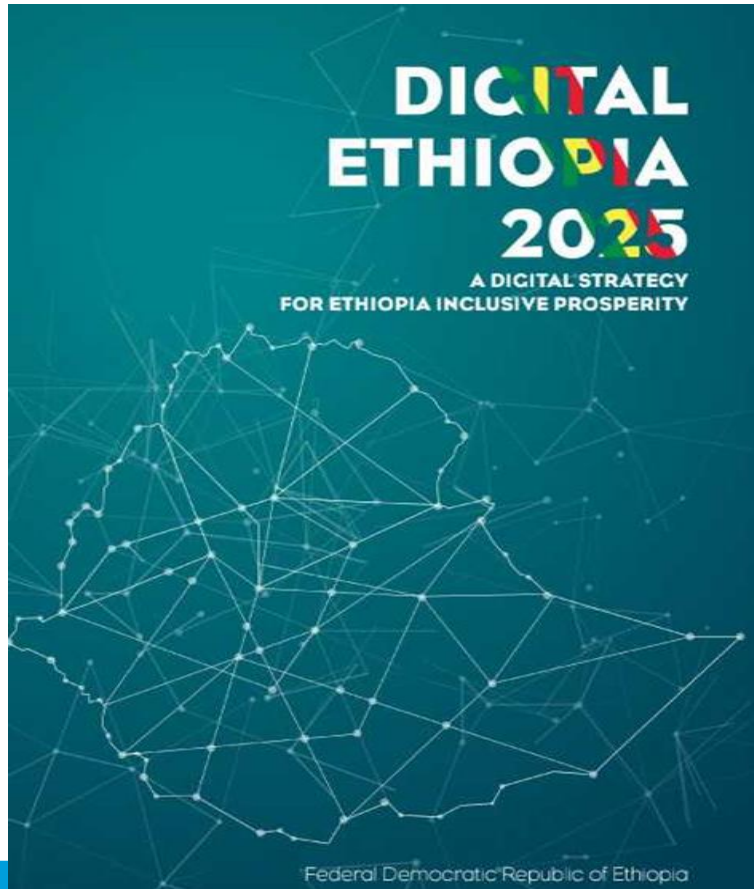

- Digital literacy
