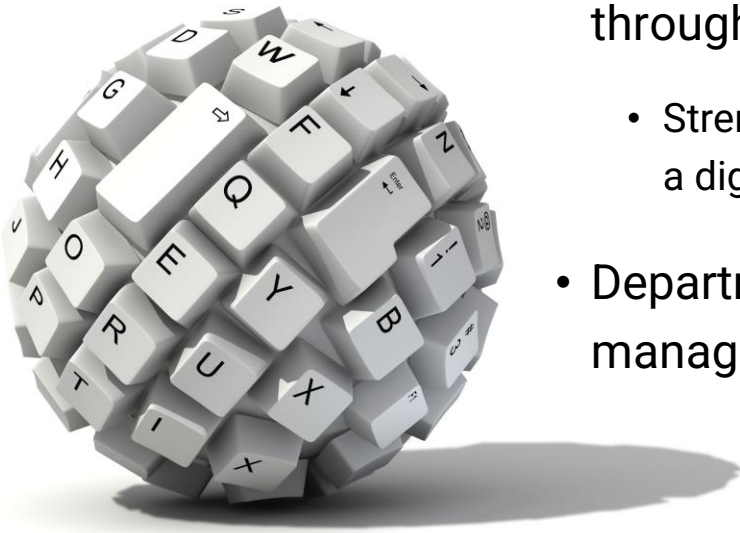

- Department of Open Data (Open Data Center) oversees open data policy, manages infrastructure like Open Data portal, evaluates its impact, etc.





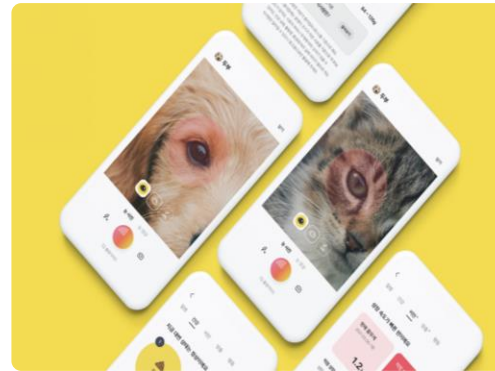
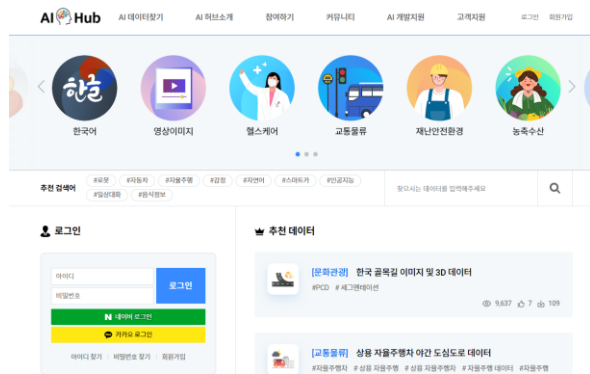

1. What are some emerging and important trends of OGD, especially in responding to pandemics, climate change, digital urban planning, digital economy, and in the accelerated achievement of the SGDs?

- ① Civic participation drives the development of OGD
 - During Covid-19 Pandemic, Mask Locator App was developed in Korea by collaborating with civil society
- ② Leveraging Open Government Data for AI development
 - Implementation of AI training datasets has led to innovative service development.
 - Exploration of synthetic and unstructured data is expected to increase the value of OGD





2. How do we ensure that OGD delivers for concrete outcomes and real impacts and SDGs, and beyond “window dressing” (e.g. opening data sets that are not useful)?

- ① Enhance the quality of OGD to increase usability for data users
 - Release user-friendly data in the format of Open API
 - “Open Data Usability Diagnostic Service” : 5 criteria (Understandability, Ease of processing, Linkability, Compliance, Importance)
- ② Proactively engage with data users and promote Public-Private Partnership
 - “If Governments wish to move beyond simply “window dressing” their data, **potential end users** should both be guided towards the data, but also **considered in deciding which data to open up**. – United Nations
 - Open Data Strategy Council(ODSC) joined by private sector, Open Data Forum(ODF), Hackathon, etc.
