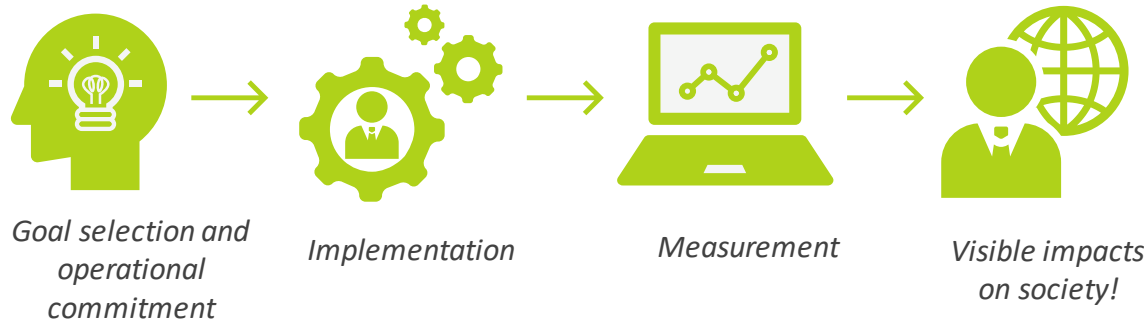
Expert Panel for Sustainable Development:

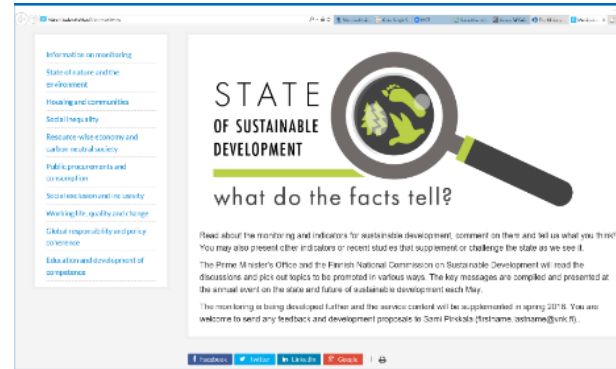
Participatory National Follow-up and review system - online

Citizens' Panel on sustainable development in Finland

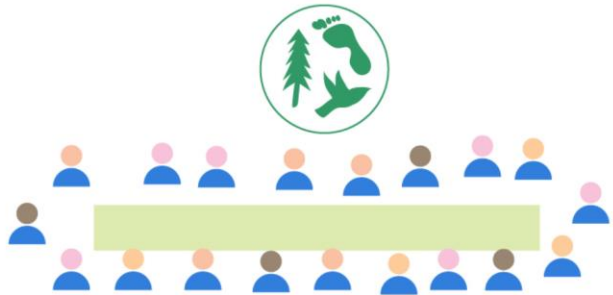
