

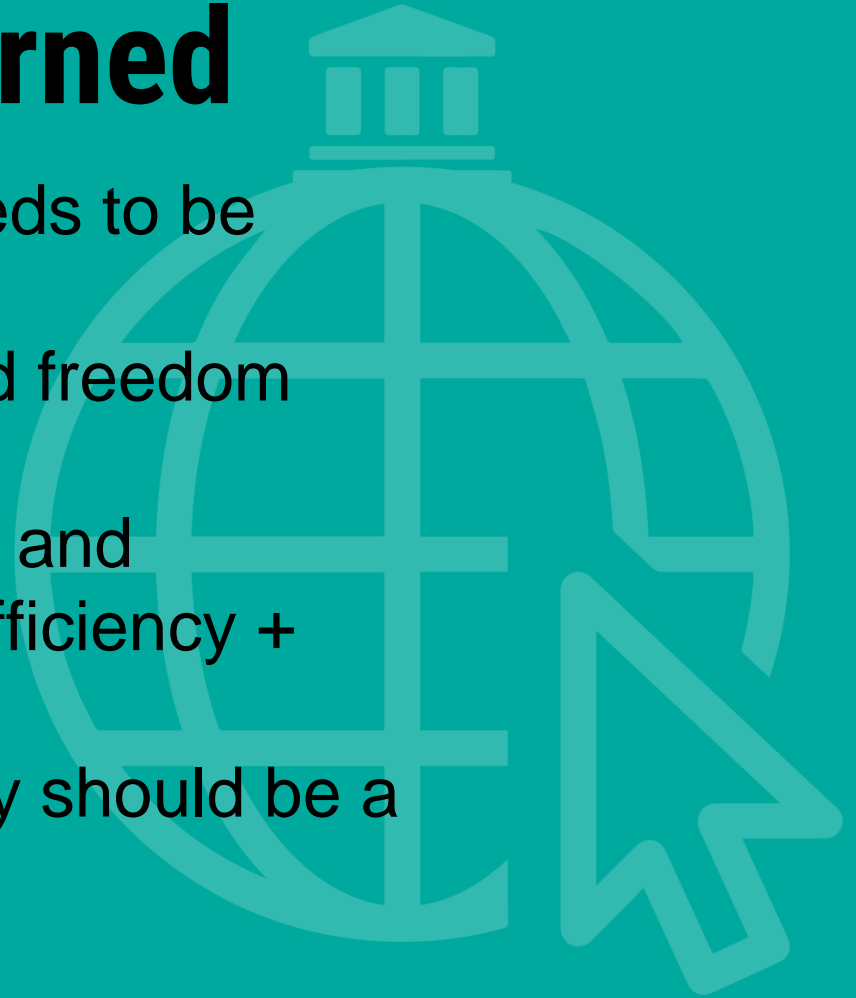

- Produce disaggregated data to develop group-specific solutions
- Address both access and uses of the internet
- Look at measures to address both the supply and demand side of access
- Address underlying causes of digital exclusion

 - Map risks and vulnerabilities => Carry out gender and human rights impact assessments for digital policies
